SUSTAINABILITY

Our coffins are one of the most ecological options, utmost care is put into sourcing all the materials. Organic hemp is used for the load-bearing rope handles, local timber for the fixings and frame slats. Woven Farewell is one of the only coffin manufacturers to donate profits to charity. We give 5% of our profits to the Woodland Trust, reflecting the central place that death has within life.

Our nameplates are carefully handpainted onto local ash wood



Our willow coffins are woven in a petal shape with one flat and one rounded end, using willow grown in Somerset. They are lined with biodegradable leak proof plastic and a calico cotton layer. The coffin design can be varied on request to add different willow colours, be woven with two round ends or in a traditional coffin shape. They are certified for cremation, appropriate for burial, and compliant with natural burial site regulations. Our coffins are weight tested to 20 stone and can be delivered within 48 hours of payment.
